Sunday, July 20 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

*Security guards will patrol the area Friday & Saturday evenings from 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. the next morning. It is the decision and responsibility of each exhibitor if he or she leaves a booth assembled and merchandise unattended at any time. The Highland Business Association, its agents and representatives assume no responsibility for any booths and/or merchandise associated with any exhibitor.

Registration...

New applicants and 2007 exhibitors are invited to complete the attached registration form and return it to the Highland Business Association. **DEADLINE April 1, 2008.** Notification of acceptance will be sent by May 1, 2008.

New applicants and 2007 artists not pre-juried:

Booth Fee: \$195 (plus non-refundable \$25 for jury fee; **please write separate check**), \$195 booth fee check will be returned by June 1 if not accepted into the 2008 Highland Fest Art Fair.

Returning 2007 pre-juried exhibitors:

Booth Fee: \$195. **One-half of booth fee refunded if cancellation prior to June 1, 2008.** No refunds provided thereafter. All participants are required to meet the April 1 deadline.

Exhibit Art Requirements...

- ❖ One Artist/Studio Per Booth
- ❖ Original Art Created by Exhibitor/Studio
- ❖ No Manufactured, Imported, Commercial, or Kit Work Accepted
- ❖ No Dealers or Agents
- ❖ Exhibit Space Not to Exceed 10' x 10' (Reservation for a second space may be requested **for an additional cost.**)

Slides...

Entrants to be juried are required to submit three 35mm slides that represent work which will be displayed at the Highland Fest Art Fair. Slides of accepted exhibitors will be returned after the fair.

- ◆ No glass mounts on slides
- ◆ Name and number on all three slides
- ◆ Identify TOP of slide
- ◆ Identify medium on each slide
- ◆ Provide full description of each slide on side 2 of registration form
- ◆ Photos will NOT be accepted
- ◆ **All decisions of jurors are final**

Judging and Awards...

Judging will take place Saturday morning, July 19. First, Second, Third, and Best of Show awards will be announced in the fine arts (2-dimensional art) and fine crafts (3-dimensional art) categories that afternoon.
